**READ** Acts 4:1-22

**EXAMINE** Acts 4:1-22

- What happens in this passage?
- Who is involved?
- When do these events take place?
- How do the religious leaders respond to Peter & John speaking to the people?
- What does Peter say to these leaders?
- Why do you think Peter and John are such a threat to the religious leaders?

**APPLY** Acts 4:1-22

- What has disturbed you recently?
- What are your thoughts about Christians today who are arrested for preaching/teaching or for witnessing for the Lord?
- Consider doing a study on the persecuted church in the world today.
- By what power do you do what you do?
- How are you allowing your life to be filled with the Holy Spirit?
- What lessons did you learn from Peter's message in this passage?
