READ Luke 9:18-27

OPEN

- What training, if any, have you had in life saving, including first aid?
- What do people say today about Jesus?

DIG

- What is Jesus doing in verse 18? Is he alone or with others? What is the significance of this?
- What are the crowds saying about Jesus at this time?
- Why do you think Jesus asks the question he asks in verse 20?
- How does Peter answer this question?
- Why do you think Jesus warned them not to tell anyone about him being the Christ of God?
- What are themes you can discover in verses 22-27?

REFLECT

- How is your private prayer life? Who do you pray with on a regular basis?
- Why is it so important to know who Jesus is?
- When did you first confess Jesus as the Christ of God? If you haven't yet, are you willing to make this confession? What keeps you from confessing Christ?
- What might it mean to us today to "take up our cross and follow Jesus?"
- How can we save our life? How can we lost it?
