R.E.A.P. God's Word

READ Acts 4:23-31

EXAMINE Acts 4:23-31

- What motivates the people to pray in this passage? What is the setting?
- How do the people address God?
- Where in Scripture do the people go to pray?
- What current events, political figures are mentioned in the prayer of the early church?
- What place does Jesus have in their prayer?
- What do they ask God to do?
- What happens?

APPLY Acts 4:23-31

- What motivates you to pray?
- Where do you usually pray? Are you currently praying with others on a regular basis? If not, why not?
- How do you bring the Psalms into your prayer life?
- How do you pray about current events and contemporary political figures?
- What place does Jesus have in your prayer?
- What are you asking God to do for you and for the Church at this time?
- What did you learn from this passage about us becoming a praying church?
