Study Questions

June 27 – July 3, 2016

READ 1 Samuel 17:12-24

EXPLORE 1 Samuel 17:12-24

- Vs. 12, Describe David's place in the family. How old might David have been?
- Vs. 13, Which of David's brothers went to war?
- Vs. 14-15, Compare David's role to those of his brothers.
- Vs. 16, At least how long had the armies been formed and what occurred each day?
- Vs. 17-19, What mission was David given by his father?
- Vs. 20-23, Describe the battle formations and the actions taken by both sides?
- Vs. 24, What was the response of Israelites?

APPLY 1 Samuel 17:12-24

- How does your place in your family compare with that of David's? Do you believe it has impacted you? How?
- Vs. 12 begins with "Now David". In your life, have you had a person like David enter into the fearful times of your life. If so, describe.
- This passage is, in essence, a siege. When have you felt under siege in your life?
- Vs. 23b hints at David's upcoming actions. How does this compare with that of the soldiers of Israel?
- How do these verses teach us to respond to sieges and giants in our lives?
- How can you be a David in another person's life?
