Study Questions

July 11 – July 17, 2016

READ 1 Sam 17:41-58

EXPLORE 1 Samuel 17:41-58

- Vs. 41, How does “Meanwhile” tie this text to the previous verses & who goes out with Goliath? Who goes out with David?
- Vs 42-44, What is Goliath’s reaction upon seeing David?
- Vs. 45-46, What is David’s reply to Goliath?
- Vs. 47, Upon whom does David rely and to whom does David give credit?
- Vs. 48-51, Describe the battle and its aftermath.
- How well is David known prior to the Battle?
- Vs 52-58, What is Saul’s response to the battle and how does David then define himself now that he is known?

APPLY 1 Sam 17:41-58

- We may have “meanwhile” events in life. How does this passage teach us to respond to them?
- We may be misjudged or “dissed” by someone as David was. How does this passage inform our response to such an occurrence?
- When we go up against the “giants” in our lives, to whom do we look and to whom do we credit the victory?
- How can we look to the Lord for victory in our lives?
- David, after such a great victory remains humble before Saul. How should we see ourselves after great victories or achievements in life?
- How do the three prior questions “dovetail” with each other?
