Study Questions
July 18 – July 24, 2016

READ 1 Sam 18:1-12

EXPLORE 1 Samuel 18: 1-12

- Vs. 1-4, How does Jonathan respond to David?
- Vs. 2 & 5, How does Saul respond to David?
- Vs. 6-7, How do others respond to David and how is this manifested?
- Vs. 8-9, How does Saul now respond to David's acclaim?
- Vs. 10-11, What then happens to Saul and what is the resulting action?
- Vs. 12, How does Saul now feel about David and why?

APPLY 1 Sam 18:1-12

- Have you had a friend with whom you became "one spirit"? Describe it in your own words.
- What covenant(s) might we enter into with a friend?
- Saul's jealousy is very "human". Have you experienced it in your life either within yourself or others?
- What song lyrics might someone compose about you and your life?
- What can be the negative consequences of jealousy? What doorways do jealousies open in our lives? Are any results positive?
- Have you witnessed person's jealousies try to "pin someone to the wall? What were the consequences?
- A vivid picture of one's jealousies of another's successes is drawn here. In your experience, do such jealousies ever draw one closer to God?
- Why do jealousies arise and what life practices can we exercise to avoid them and their destructive results?
