## ***FAREWELL TO THE EPHESIANS***

### Study Questions

Jul 20 - 26, 2015

**READ** Acts 20: 17-38

**EXPLORE** Acts 20 17-38

- Vs. 17, who came to Miletus from Ephesus at Paul's invitation??
- Vs. 18-21, 34-35, what was the basis for Paul's confidence among the elders?
- Vs. 19, how did Paul serve in the midst of prosecution?
- Vs. 22-24, how does the Holy Spirit comfort and lead Paul in his visit to other cities and the upcoming visit to Jerusalem?
- Vs. 25-27, how can Paul say he is innocent of any blood in Ephesus?
- Vs. 28-31, what warning does Paul give the elders?
- Vs. 32-35 to whom and what does Paul commit the elders in his last visit with them?
- Vs. 36-38 how does Paul close his time with them and what is their response?

**APPLY** Acts 20: 17-38

- Paul expresses great confidence in his relationship with the Ephesians. Consider what level your own confidence level is.
- In vs. 24 simply states his life goal. How does this encourage us in establishing our own life goal(s)?
- Even after such a firm faith based church is established, Paul warns of "savage wolves" moving in. Have you witnessed such attacks and how were they or how should they be handled?
- Paul's ending statement is about giving. Consider how to apply this to our lives as it relates to our confidence in our Christian witness.
- This passage expresses many varying emotions, spend time dwelling on them and consider how they can open up our own lives and enhance our relationships with others in our church and in our communities.

- Vs. 10, Paul's response to Eutychus' fall
- Vs.11-12, the meeting continues and concludes
- Vs. 13-16, Paul's continuing travel towards Jerusalem.
