Study Questions

John 3:22-36

READ: John 4:1-14

EXPLORE: John 4:1-14

- Why did Jesus leave Judea? What had he been doing in Galilee?
- Locate Samaria on a map. Read Gen. 33:19 for the historical reference to Jacob's well.
- Why did Jesus stop at the well and what does this teach us about Him?
- What did Jesus ask of the Samaritan woman? Did He ask or command her?
- What cultural bounds did Jesus cross when addressing her? Why did Jews disassociate themselves from Samaritans?
- What initially puzzling response does Jesus give to the Samaritan's question?
- What reply does the woman make? Is her response understandable?
- Jesus answers by comparing what two types of water? What are the profound traits of the water Jesus offers?

APPLY: John 4:1-14

- Jesus crosses social, cultural and religious boundaries in his ministry. Do we dare cross such boundaries in ours?
- Jesus uses a very practical situation as a means of teaching. What model can this provide us in our daily lives?
- Jesus addresses both physical thirst and spiritual thirst. How can we address both physical and spiritual needs in our lives and in our communities?
- The woman challenges Jesus regarding his ability to obtain "this water" and is he greater than Jacob? Non-believers may challenge us as to the gospel we offer and why is it better than any other teaching. How is our response informed by that of Jesus?
- Most importantly, do you drink from the water of eternal life in order to share it with others?

PRAY AND PRACTICE: What life lesson will you put into practice from this passage this week from John 4:1-14?
