READ John 4:43-54

EXPLORE John 4:43-54

- What statement does Jesus make, that John cites, as his reason for returning to Galilee?
- How is Jesus received in Galilee and Cana?
- Why did they receive him in this way?
- Who came to see Jesus at Cana and why?
- What did this person ask of Jesus and where was the person's son?
- What is Jesus' initial response? And, how does the man then respond?
- What "command" does Jesus give the man?
- How does the man respond and what does he find on the way home?
- Upon investigation, what does the man find out about his son being made well?
- What is the consequence for the man and his family?

APPLY John 4:43-54

- Have you ever experienced being "a prophet without respect" in your own world? How do you handle it?
- The man asked Jesus to heal his son by following him, but Jesus had his own plan. How can we apply this to our own lives?
- What do we learn about the breadth of Jesus' authority?
- A man who desperately wants his son healed, obeys the instruction of Jesus. How can we apply this to our lives? How does it inform our own faith walk?
- Following Jesus' instructions results in lives changed. Have you an area in your life that could benefit from following his instructions? Are you willing?
