Luke 11:14-28

**READ** Luke 11:29-36

**REFLECT** on Luke 11:29-36

- How many people heard Jesus' teaching in this passage?
- How might this crowd have responded to what Jesus was saying?
- What is Jesus' view of his generation? Why?
- Why do you think Jesus compares his generation to Jonah's and to Solomon's generations?
- What is the "sign of Jonah"? Read Jonah 2, especially 2:10.
- In what way does Jesus compare our life to a lamp?

- What are some concerns you have with our current "generation" of people living on this planet today?
