THE SPIRIT OF GOD

Study Questions

Aug 15 – Aug 21, 2016

READ Psalm 59

EXPLORE Psalm 59

- To what do the preface notes indicate this Psalm is related?
- Vs 1-4, How do these verses relate to the action in Psalm 19? In David's plight, what actions does he take for his survival?
- Vs. 5-10, What is the depth of his plight, but to whom does David assign true power?
- Vs. 11-13, What does David ask of God and to whom does he want glory given?
- Vs. 14-15, Contrast the actions of those after David with David himself.
- Vs. 16a, When, and for what and whom, does David sing?
- Vs 16b-17, How is this praise song closed?

APPLY Psalm 59

- Have you ever felt like you were in a fortress surrounded by an enemy? If so when?
- What model does David provide for prayer in vs. 3-7? Do you pray in this manner when troubled?
- How can vs 8-10 bring perspective to our own lives?
- Who does David want to see glorified by his rescue from his enemies? How does this instruct us in our own prayers?
- Do we sing or offer praise and prayers to God in the morning? What benefit can be derived from doing so?
- In David's life dilemma, he concludes his song with praise and confidence in the Lord. Re-read the conclusion in 17b. How can we better rely on our God for all our needs and our trust in Him for our "rescues"?
- **PRACTICE & PRAY:** How can you apply the lessons of this study to your upcoming week?

SCRIPTURE: 1Samuel 19: 11-24

Intro: Saul's further two attempts to kill David which the Spirit of God foils.

MESSAGE NOTES

- Vs. 11-16, Saul's plot and Michal's aid.
- Vs.17, Michal's alibi.
- Vs. 18-19, David goes with Samuel.
- Vs. 19-24, Saul tries a second time, but the Spirit of God protects His anointed David in a most unusual way.
- Lessons from 1 Samuel 19:1-10
