Study Questions
Aug 3– Aug 9, 2015

READ Acts 21: 17 - 26

EXPLORE Acts 21: 17-26

- Vs. 17-1: Who greeted them in Jerusalem and how were they received?
- Vs. 19-20: What did Paul first tell those listening and how did they first respond?
- Vs. 21-22: What concern is expressed regarding Paul?
- Vs. 23-24: A solution is proposed,. What was it?
- Vs. 25:A reference is made to the instructions given to Gentile believers in Acts 18:19-21. Reread these verses. How does this reflect upon the desire for a unified Church?
- Vs. 26: How does Paul respond to the proposed solution? Did Paul respond this way for his own safety or for what other reason?

APPLY Acts 21: 17-26

- The people respond with praise to God after hearing Paul's account,.How then should we respond upon hearing of the spread of the gospel?
- Praising God serves not only God, but ourselves as well. How can we apply this to our own lives?
- Paul compromises in this passage to better facilitate peace in the Church. How can we be called to compromise as well? Are such compromises threats to our faith? How can we best handle such occasions? How are they important to our own church's life?
- Paul's acceptance of the rite of purification was not viewed by Paul as necessary in the salvation he already had in Jesus Christ. But, he performs these rites publicly. What lesson is there in this model of Paul's and how can we apply it to our own lives?
