## DAVID AND JONATHAN

### Study Questions

Aug 22 – Aug 28, 2016

#### READ 1 SAMUEL 20:1-15

#### EXPLORE 1 Samuel 20:1-15

- Vs. 1-2, How do David's and Jonathan's puzzlement compare?
- Vs. 3-4, Contrast David's oath with Jonathan's promise.
- Vs. 5-8a, Describe David's concern and plan.
- Vs. 8b-9, How does Jonathan react to David's assertion in vs 8b.?
- Vs. 12-13a, What is Jonathan's promise and what consequence does he call for if he fails his promise?
- Vs 13b-15, In the midst of this struggle, what does Jonathan seek?

#### APPLY 1 Samuel 20: 1-15

- Have you ever felt like you were in a fortress surrounded by an enemy? If so when?
- Have you or a loved one ever cried out "Why is this happening? I've done nothing to deserve this". How does this Psalm speak to such a situation?
- Have you, or do you have, a "Jonathan" in your life? What can you do to cultivate such a friendship?
- Are you, or have you been, a "Jonathan" in another's life? What can you do to cultivate such a relationship?
- What model for their friendship does Jonathan call upon in 14-15?
- How does this relationship further God's plan for David? Has such a relationship furthered God's will for your life? If so, when? Our Triune God is a relationship model for us. Consider how you might be God's instrument in relationships you now have.
- **PRACTICE & PRAY:** How can you apply the lessons of this study to your upcoming week?
