REFLECT on Luke 12:1-12

- How many people hear Jesus speak in this passage? What problems were there with crowd control?
- What warnings does Jesus offer to this crowd?
- What spiritual troubles does Jesus warn against?
- What is the worth of sparrows? How are sparrows viewed by God? How does this relate to us today?
- What happens to those who acknowledge Jesus and to those who disown Jesus?
- What happens to those who blaspheme against the Holy Spirit?
- What will the Holy Spirit teach us and when?

RESPOND to Luke 12:1-12

- What lessons did you learn from studying Luke 12:1-12?
- What has God made known to you, revealed to you?
- What do you fear?
- How might God's care of sparrows change your view of God's care for your life?
- In what ways do you acknowledge or disown Jesus?
- What is the Holy Spirit teaching you? How is the Holy Spirit helping you?
