READ Acts 8:1-8

EXPLORE Acts 8:1-8

- What is Saul doing in this passage?
- What breaks out against the early church?
- Who leaves and who stays in Jerusalem?
- Where do people flee to? Why there?
- How is Stephen's body treated and by whom?
- What does Saul begin to try to do? How does he do this?
- What does the church do when scattered?
- Learn about Philip: where does he go? Compare Acts 1:8 to Acts 8:5.
- What does Philip do? How do the crowds respond? How do evil spirits respond?
- What is the result in Samaria?

APPLY Acts 8:1-8

- In what ways have you faced persecution or at least opposition to your faith?
- What has motivated you to move to a different city or state in the past?
- If you were face to face with a person like Saul in Acts 8:1-8, how do you think you would respond?
