INTRO:

SCRIPTURE Acts 23:12 - 35

MESSAGE

- Vs. 23:12-15, a conspiracy is formed, and oaths taken, and a plot hatched.
- Vs. 16-22, Paul and the commander are informed about the plot from a surprising source.
- Vs. 23-30, the Commander sends Paul to Felix to be tried.
- Vs 31-35, Paul is held for trial, but his accusers are summoned as well.
- Lessons from Acts 23:12 – 35
