Study Questions
Sept.22--29, 2013

READ Luke 12:49-59

REFLECT on 12:49-59

- What does Jesus say he is coming to bring (verse 49, 51)?
- What must happen first? What is the “baptism” Jesus mentions in this passage?
- According to Jesus’ teaching, why will families be divided?
- How do we know when it is going to rain? What are the signs?
- How do we know how to interpret the signs of “this present time”?
- What are we to do in relationship with adversaries? What are the hardest steps in “trying hard to be reconciled”?

RESPOND to Luke 12:49-59

- What are some “signs” you have a hard time understanding?
- In what ways does Jesus bring peace, and in what ways does he bring division?
- How has your faith in Christ influenced your family life?
- How can we be better at understanding the “present time” we live in?
- What is most difficult for you in “judging what is right”?
- What relationship in your life right now needs the work of Christ’s reconciling grace? How will you “try hard to be reconciled” with that person?
