**READ** 1 Sam. 21:10–22:5

**EXPLORE** Psalm 34

- After leaving Nob, where did David flee? Why do you think he went there?
- What is unique about the town of Gath? (see 1 Sam. 17:4)
- What do the people of Gath think about David? What is inaccurate and what is accurate about their views of David?
- Why was David afraid in Gath? What does he do about this?
- How does the King of Gath respond to David? How does this response help David?
- Where does David go after leaving Gath?
- Some believe David wrote Psalm 34 from this cave. Read Psalm 34 in light of the cave of Adullam.
- Who gathers around David at this cave?
- Where does David go next after the cave?
- What is unique about the land of Moab in relation to David's family? (see intro to Book of Ruth).
- Where does David go after Moab? Why?

**APPLY** 1 Sam 21:10–22:5

- What can we learn today from David's odd travels from this passage?
- When have you been afraid and gone into some form of hiding?
- When have you pretended to be something other than your true self in order to protect yourself?
- What is life like from inside a cave? Consider other types of "caves" besides physical caves.
- Who in your life is in distress, in debt, or discontented? How can you provide support to these people?
