Study Questions
Sept.29—Oct. 6, 2013

READ Luke 13:1-17

REFLECT on 13:1-17

- What concern is brought to Jesus in verse 1? How does Jesus address this concern? What warning and instruction does he give?
- Examine the Parable of the Fig Tree:
 - Who is involved?
 - What happens?
 - When and how long does the action occur?
 - Where does this story take place?
 - Why do you think Jesus tells this story?
- What happens while Jesus is in “one of the synagogues” in verses 10-17?
- How do people respond?

RESPOND to Luke 13:1-17

- How do you make sense of violence that happens in this world, including religious violence?
- What can we learn from Jesus’ way of looking at life?
- What does it mean to “repent”?
- What did you learn from the parable of the fig tree? What is God looking for in our life?
- What is currently causing you to be “imprisoned” or boxed in?
- Who do you know that is living in a kind of prison in their way of life, in their health, or in their spiritual outlook?

PRAY & PRACTICE: What one activity will you do this week in response to your study in Luke today?
