Study Questions

Sept. 7-13, 2014

R.E.A.P. God's Word

READ Acts 7:54—8:1

EXPLORE Acts 7:54—8:1

- How the religious leaders receive Stephen's testimony? Describe their hearts.
- How is Stephen described? Compare Acts 7:55 with Acts 6:3, and Acts 6:5.
- Compare Acts 7:55 with Acts 7:2 and the theme of God's glory.
- Compare Acts 7:56 with Mark 14:61-62.
- Why do you think the religious leaders covered their ears and yelled at the top of their voices?
- What then did they do to Stephen? Why?
- Who is mentioned for the first time in the Book of Acts in 7:58 and Acts 8:1?
- Compare Stephen's final words/prayers, with Jesus' final words prayers (Acts 7:59-60 with Luke 23:46 and Luke 23:34).
- What happens after Stephen is put to death?

APPLY Acts 7:54—8:1

- What is your testimony of faith? With whom have you shared your faith story recently?
- What fills your life? What 3-5 main qualities describe your character?
- How has the God of glory appeared to you? Recall a vision you've had of God's glory.
- Who in your life currently stands against your faith? How do you relate to this person?
- What can you learn from Stephen's final words about God's way of loving others, including enemies of the faith? See Matthew 5:43-48.
- At this time, how do you think you would face martyrdom, being put to death for your faith in Jesus?
- What is your mission, and where is God sending you to be a missionary?
