PAUL TALKS WITH FELIX

Study Questions
Oct 5 – Oct 11, 2015

READ Acts 24: 17-27

EXPLORE Acts 24: 17-27

- Vs. 17-18, what gift had Paul brought to Jerusalem? And, why was Paul “ceremonially clean”?
- Vs.19-20, who does Paul suggest should also be present at this trial and what challenge does he offer his accusers?
- Vs 21, to what “charge” does Paul admit guilt?
- Vs 22-23, what “decision” does Felix make and how is Paul treated following this phase of his trial?
- Vs 24-27, of whom and what does Paul speak when he next appears before Felix? Describe Felix’s subsequent relationship with Paul.
- How long is Paul held by Felix?

APPLY 24: 17-27

- What examples are we given here of actions we can take for which no one can accuse us?
- Paul faces the full power of Rome and Jerusalem, yet shows great assurance. How can this be manifested in our lives?
- Consider verse 21. Paul stood for the resurrection. Before whom we take a stand and for what? Give an example of the last time you felt you “took a stand”.
- Once again, God’s call on Paul’s life to witness in Rome seems less than a direct route. Is that so? Is there an example in your life of a sense of God’s call and on what path did His plan take you?
