#### **CCI Latin America - Adam**

This month (April) we are beginning the first phase of a project that we have dreamed about for the last few years, creating a Resource Center for camping leaders in Latin America. You may recall that our Camping Association is the largest geographically of the associations in the world, including Mexico, Central America and South America. As an organization, we focus on two primary goals:

- 1.) Fulfilling the great commission through the medium of Christian Camping
- 2.) Training and supporting the next generation of leaders through Christian Camping

This project involved the compilation of almost 50 years of resources, ranging from magazine publications, to workshops, to translated books. CCI Latin America is an organization built on relationships and face-to-face interactions, due to cultural norms. However, as the largest association in the world, it is often very difficult to be able to have 13 country leaders meet together regularly. With this in mind, it is becoming increasingly more important to have means of communication and access to resources digitally, using existing technology.

We will be creating a resource center for Christian Camping leaders in Latin America. Of course our personal, face-to-face events will continue where possible! This resource center will be support our events and feed and train our leaders around region.

I am in charge of this project and it will involve many hours, days and weeks of translating, organizing and presenting years or resources. We have finished Phase #1 with the assistance and donations of the Christian Camping Northwest in the U.S.. This first phase is the structure for how we will present and organize all the information, including: Website, Digital Resource Center, Encrypted User access and more!

### **Exchange Programs - 2013**

This year will be the fourth year with our International Exchange programs. We are sending five young leaders to the United States from the countries of Panama and Costa Rica. # Andrea - Decima Potencia (Tenth Potential) Ministry Update

This year Decima Potencia began it's operations with force, networking and creating alliances to fulfill the desire to "Highlight the value of Adolescents".

One of the partnerships we have established is with Camp Roblealto, with whom we are conducting a study of feasibility to start promoting a Teen Camp called "DECISIONS: Stop, Think, Act". It aims to promote the development of skills to face life and prudent decision-making, in addition to promoting values, where we always have the opportunity to plant a seed of the God's word.

In the same way, we are working in partnership with the Saving Lives Foundation (Fundacion Rescatando Vidas) which promotes training for students, parents and teachers in various subjects. They promote activities to prevent suicide and self-destructive behavior and together we develop programs and activities in schools to prevent these high-risk behaviors and motivate them in their lives.

Decima Potencia continues to be a resource for other nonprofit organizations such as Casa Luz; a temporary home to teenage mothers with their children, where we have developed plans together for the restoration and strengthening of their lives.

On the other hand, we have opened doors to create spaces and opportunities for teenagers and young people, so that they can have the chance to be guided and encouraged, develop their potential as individuals and focus on personal development issues.

In each of these alliances and possible activities, God is giving us the opportunity to approach more teenagers and bring hope through the guidance of His Word, which fills us with joy, courage and strength to move forward. Pray that God continues to open roads where there are not and to reach the hearts of these kids who need hope and the lord!

Most suffer from abuse (sexual, physical, emotional), live in atrocious conditions, without running water and basic sanitary services, malnutrition, and drug dealing around them. The organization Cedcas works every day in the community, providing education, health care, and a refuge through their programs. Through our partnership with Cedcas and their leader Hugo Salas, we provide the Hope Project camps and give the kids opportunity to be away from their environment and hear a message of hope.

Two weeks ago, after many years in the community, a drug dealer and gang began threatening Hugo Salas, his team and the kids that participate. This group wants them to leave the community and has attacked them, threatened physical harm, fire and even death. We are dealing with this very real evil right now together and providing support as we can. Please pray that God will have his hand on this community and our organizations!
