

School for the Mangyan 3rd grade kids starts June 13. We told them to arrive on June 11. They will be coming from villages throughout the island of Mindoro.

Pray that all those we have picked and those God indeed wants to study under our program will indeed show up without any hindrances.

Just heard from Lenie who is in Safa (the village where 8 of the students will be coming from) that one of the kids was recently bitten by a dog. The dog seemed to be mad, but they killed it and ate it anyway. The child had not yet been brought to a clinic for Rabi shots. Often the people are so poor here that they don't have money even to take their child on public transport, which would actually be only a couple of dollars. I told Lenie to encourage the parents of the child to take him to the clinic immediately and we will pay for whatever the cost is.

Pray also that Raquel and I and Jesson will continue to have the good health He has given us – we'll need it especially for the next 10 months. :)
Jesson ended up with a boil on his elbow (first boil he claims he has ever had), which has now limited his ability in helping us get ready for the school kids.
